In addition, Esther was chairwoman of the St. Stephen Mission Committee and the ELCA Synod Mission Board. She was also Sunday school teacher and Luther League Leader at Hemnes Lutheran Church. In 2002, Esther was inducted into the Pride in the Tiger Foundation Hall of Fame.

In her later years Esther enjoyed writing children's short stories. Esther loved Jesus Christ and enjoyed sharing Him with others.

Esther is survived by her sister-in-law, Marion Johnson of Minneota, MN; her nieces and nephews, Laurie (Dave) Boom of Montrose, SD, Steve Johnson of Omaha, NE, Tricia (Ken) Paradis of Marshall, MN, Paula (David) Wells of Falling Waters, WV and Joyce (Wes) Shepherd of Marietta, MN along with many great nieces and great nephews.
