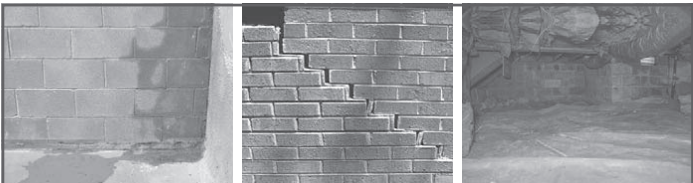
Alta Vista Township
