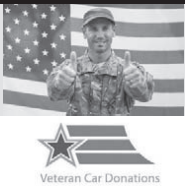

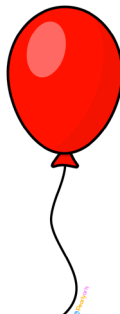

A Public Hearing will be held on the 19th of November, at 9:30 a.m. at the Lyon County Government Center 607 West Main Street, Marshall, Minnesota in the County Commissioners Room for the purpose of hearing concerns, receiving testimony, and other information regarding the proposed Lyon County Ordinance. No.: 25 An Ordinance to Regulate Cannabis Businesses.

The following is a summary pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Section 375.51 and Minnesota Statutes 331A.01, of sections within the following proposed Lyon County Ordinance:

Ordinance No.: 25, An Ordinance of Lyon County to Regulate Cannabis Businesses:

This Cannabis Oriented Business Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority delegated to Lyon County by Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 342.

SECTION 1: Administration. This Cannabis Oriented Business Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority delegated to Lyon County by Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 342. Section 1 includes, Authority and Jurisdiction, Severability, Enforcement, and Definitions,

SECTION 2: Registration of Cannabis Businesses. Any requirements listed to obtain a cannabis retail license from Lyon County.

SECTION 3: Requirements for Cannabis Businesses. This will indicate Hours of Operation, location limitations, and restrictions of registrations of licensed cannabis businesses.

SECTION 4: Temporary Cannabis Events. Any requirements listed to obtain a temporary cannabis license or permit from Lyon County.

SECTION 5: Lower-Potency Hemp Edibles. Permit requirements and mandatory conditions regarding lower-potency hemp edibles.
