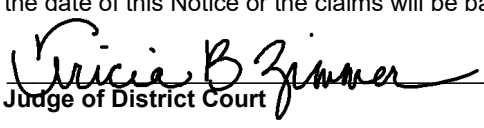

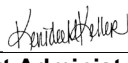
Notice is given that an application for informal appointment of Personal Representative has been
